This is a great opportunity for people who have not grown edibles before to take plants away even if they have not brought any - we are sharing as well as swapping. Bring a re-used carrier bag if possible. Edible York is getting together with YoCo for this event. Drop in at any time.

We will be outside weather-permitting, or inside the church if need be. All other activities will be in the church.

The rest of the YoCo event includes plotting growing sites on a map of York; a discussion about greenspaces on York Central - beyond the masterplan; and what will the public space on York Central be like, how will it be run, will it really be public and democratic? Please come along at a time to suit, or stay for the whole two hours.

YoCo - York Central Co-owned has a vision for how the York Central site can be developed to meet the needs of the people of the city. Themes important to this vision include housing, green environment, places to learn and play, a thriving local economy and low carbon transport. Edible York is and has been active in the Leeman Road area for many years, with the apple storage container, collaborations with gardening groups and the primary school.
